Equipment Provided

- Shooting Shirt
- Uniform – must be turned in at the end of the year
 - Failure to turn in your uniform at the end of the season may result in being billed for the cost of new uniform
- First year players get:
 - Practice Jersey – will use each year in the program
 - Sweatshirt – will keep for duration they play in the program
- Online Store
 - Will provide when available

Practices

- Vary in times and locations. Teams will practice all nights of the week, including Wednesdays and Fridays.
- Schedules will be sent out monthly for practices
- Please talk to your child about appropriate behavior in the school building & on the school grounds while waiting to get picked up or before the start of practice.

24 Hour Rule

- An individual is not to approach a coach to discuss a game, a game incident or a situation that occurred during the game that has provoked an adverse emotional response or a hostile situation until at least 24 hours after the fact.

Playing Time

- This is a competitive program, so playtime is not given it is earned.
- All coaches will do there best to give kids opportunities based on situations during games, but playing time could be limited or not at all on occasion.
- During the season, basketball practices and tournaments should take precedence over all activities other than family, church or school functions. If a player misses practices or games for other reasons, the coach is not required to abide by the fair and equal playing time guidelines.

Playing Time (continued)

- Players who are unhappy with your playing time should ask the following questions:
 - Am I the first one to practice and the last one to leave?
 - Do I give 100% effort 100% of the time?
 - Do I bring effort and energy to practice every day?
 - Do I support my teammates and show it?
 - Do I show up in the offseason?
 - Do I defend and rebound? If you can defend and rebound, a coach will always find room for you in the rotation.
